His vet said the cartilage in one of his ears had turned to calcium, which caused constant pain and ear infections. He has had surgery to repair this; the cartilage was removed and the ear closed. As a result, he has no hearing in that ear, but he is now healed, comfortable, and pain-free. Of course, once the pain was gone, he is showing his gratitude. Look at the smile on his face in the picture where he's racing around the yard - this is one happy dog. We think his new image gives him a special appealing look, kind of saucy, like a French beret ... and we think he is as handsome as ever.

Sky is a fantastic boy loaded with good qualities. As part of his training, he has visited homes with cats and showed no interest in them, even when one of the cats got close or took off running around him. We would say he is cat-friendly, but always recommend caution during introductions. He has also met peacocks and thinks they are not worth chasing either.

He walks well on leash and loves to spend time looking at the neighborhood's action through the window. This boy knows how to entertain himself. He loves his toys and likes to have them nearby.
